Come see preliminary information about replacing the Route 612 (Trice's Lake Road) bridge in Cumberland County. The project will extend from 0.12 miles south of Route 714 to 0.15 miles south of Route 714.

Find out about preliminary plans to replace the timber bridge with a concrete structure. The existing bridge has a 10-ton weight restriction and the purpose of this project is to remove the weight restrictions and improve safety for motorists.
