

REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL REFUSE TRANSFER STATION UPGRADES COUNTY OF CUMBERLAND, VIRGINIA

The County of Cumberland is soliciting bids from qualified contractors for the following:

- a) Construction of concrete pads for the disposal bins at two County Transfer Stations.
- b) Tar and chip (gravel) the County's three (3) Transfer Station service areas.
- c) Alternate Bid - To also include tar and chip (gravel) Samuels Drive leading to Hamilton Transfer Station off of Columbia Road (Route 690).
- d) Construction and installation of safety guard rail at three (3) County Transfer Stations.

The bids are open to all qualified, licensed and insured contractors and will require a lump sum proposal to supply all necessary materials, labor, equipment, and supervision for a completed job in accordance with County and material manufacturer's specifications. A pre-bid meeting will be held on Monday October 22, 2009 at 10:00 a.m. at the Madison Transfer Station, on Poorhouse Road (Route 728), to address any and all questions and concerns. Written, sealed bids must be received by the County Administrator at P.O. Box 110, (1 Courthouse Circle), Cumberland Virginia 23040, no later than 2:00 P.M. on Thursday October 30, 2009 for consideration. Bids will be opened and read aloud with the winning bidder contacted after Board of Supervisor approval.
