

At a meeting of the Cumberland County Board of Supervisors held at 7:30 p.m. on the 14th day of May 2007 at the Cumberland County Volunteer Rescue Squad building, Cumberland, Virginia:

The Chairman called the meeting to order and the County Administrator called the roll.

The purpose of the joint meeting was to meet with Cumberland Rescue Squad members to discuss the status and progress made by the Cumberland Rescue Squad following the adoption of a resolution by the Board of Supervisors in November 2006, which reorganized the squad. It was agreed that the key to success is recruiting additional members and that performance of the rescue squad is better than it was in November.

Chairman Osl stated that the loss of volunteers has been stabilized and applications have been received from those who are interested in joining. In addition, administrative officers have taken the burden of paperwork off of those who run calls, and calls are not being missed. The next phase is to move from the position of being stabilized toward recovery and rehabilitation of the squad. The Board suggested continuing under the same partnership for an additional period of time.

Kevin Ingle stated that he would like to continue for an additional period of time and meet again in October to re-evaluate progress.

Other Items

The County Administrator advised the Board that three bids were received on the additional compactor at Madison Transfer Station. A financial analysis of the cost savings over a period of several months was presented to the Board, and it was determined that the additional compactor would pay for itself in less than a year, and would prevent having to close the transfer station on the weekends when there is heavy trash disposal by the citizens.

On a motion by Mr. Womack and carried, the Board agreed to award the contract for rental of an additional compactor at Madison transfer station to Mr. Frank Arena, who submitted the low bid of \$500 per month.
