

At a meeting of the Cumberland County Board of Supervisors held at 7 p.m. on the 8th day of August 2007 at the Cumberland County Courthouse, Cumberland, Virginia:

The Chairman called the meeting to order and the Assistant County Administrator called the roll.

The purpose of the meeting was to hold a public hearing on bond issuance. The expected public hearing was cancelled and to be scheduled at a later date.

Mr. White expressed his concern for the fact that Blenheim Rd. is listed with a priority of 13th on the VDoT six year plan and services an estimated 243 vehicles per day. Residents of Blenheim Road had expressed their concern with the large amount of traffic serviced by the road, with much attributed to through traffic to and from Powhatan County. Mr. White informed the Board that there will be a meeting with the Blenheim Road residents and a VDoT representative on August 20, 2007 at 7 p.m. in the Cumberland County Old Clerk's Office.

Mr. Oertel requested that information be requested from the County Attorney regarding the confidentiality status of resumes that had been obtained for the Project Manager Position of the B.E.S.T. Project.

Mr. Womack requested an update from the Assistant County Administrator on the new Sheriff's Office. Mrs. Matthews stated the Emergency 911 Center had moved several weeks prior and was fully operational. Many of the Deputies and Administrative Staff had moved to the new building earlier that day. Mrs. Matthews requested that the Board give consideration to a formal name for the building to be discussed at the August 21, 2007 meeting of the Board. Mr. Oertel suggested that the Board consider recognizing the Blanton family in naming the building. Mr. Osl expressed his pleasure with the new facility and commended the County staff for their handling and coordination of the project after the outside agency managing the project was released from service.

The Chairman adjourned the meeting until the next regular meeting on August 21, 2007.
