The Chairman called the meeting to order and called the roll.

The Board met with Representatives from Longwood University to discuss the future expansion and master plan of the university. Jerry Jerome stated that he is the Campus Master Plan Coordinator and he was enlisted to meet with the local government representatives to discuss whether there is interest in being included in the planning. Phase I includes data gathering of current use of space and determining what the County would like in the way of physical characteristics over the next 50 years.

The Board mentioned that better access from Cumberland to Prince Edward County would make hundreds of acres of land available for expansion of dormitories, athletic facilities, fields, etc. and Cumberland County would welcome that expansion. Also, the airport could be used by Longwood University and the Board's vision for the future is to see improved access from Rt. 45 and Rt. 15 to the airport. Due to the close proximity of Cumberland County to Longwood's current campus, it appears logical to plan for some future facilities in Cumberland.

Much more discussion followed regarding the master plan for Longwood University, and Cumberland's desire to be included as part of the planned expansion. Mr. Jerome indicated that the time line for completing the study is June 2008.

Chairman Osl adjourned the meeting until the next regular meeting on December 18, 2007 in the Cumberland County Circuit Courtroom.
