Following the call to order by School Board Chairman Seal, Board of Supervisors Chairman Osl called the meeting to order and established that a quorum was present.

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss budget-related issues and the budget process between the two Boards. Chairman Osl stated that the Board has been meeting in work sessions, dealing with the shortfall the County is now facing. Other issues discussed were school construction, future expansion needs, combining of services between the County and School, and plans for space at the Cumberland Middle School. It was agreed that the two Boards would benefit from meeting on a regular basis in an effort to continue the communications between the School and County.
