

At an adjourned meeting of the Cumberland County Board of Supervisors held at 4:00 p.m. on the 2nd day of October, 2006 at the Cumberland County Old Clerk's Office, Cumberland, Virginia:

The Chairman called the meeting to order and the Assistant County Administrator called the roll.

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the 6-year plan with representatives from the Virginia Department of Transportation.

Keith Halbohn and Mark McKissick reviewed the current 6-year plan with the Board. After a lengthy discussion, the following updates were made to the 6-year plan for consideration at a public hearing:

- Route 624, Jenkins Church Road was moved to item #1 on the priority list
- Route 685, Miller Lane was moved to item #2 on the priority list
- Route 686, White Road was moved to item #3 on the priority list
- Route 608, Royal Oak Road was moved to the priority list as item #16
- Route 620, Stoney Point Mill Lane was moved to the final item on the priority list
- Route 703, Hunters Trail was listed as a budget item for pave in place
- Route 631, Davenport Road was listed as a budget item for pave in place

The Board and VDoT representatives discussed the Morris Road project. Mr. Halbohn informed the Board that the Verizon charges for the project would be \$9 - \$10 per foot to move phone lines for a total cost of approximately \$8,000. Mr. Halbohn had a meeting with Verizon representative scheduled for October 3, 2006 and would discuss the project at that time. The Board suggested that the County Administrator contact Ken Gilberg with Verizon to request that a temporary 800 foot line be installed during the project.

The Chairman adjourned the meeting until the regular meeting on October 17, 2006.
